


Norfolk Flora Group

Programme of Field Meetings 2008

Once again, we look forward to seeing you at many of the meetings and would like to stress that botanists of all abilities are very welcome.

The Norfolk and Norwich Naturalists' Society are holding two further 'Wild Flowers Revealed' meetings (the 18th and 19th in the series) and as usual, your assistance with these would be much appreciated. Details are included in the list.

Sat Apr 26	TG 213 423 Cromer Meet by the sea front opposite Sandcliff Hotel. If the parking by the front is full, there is a pay-and-display car park on the cliff nearby, just to the west of here. (1)
Thur May 1	TM 066 913 Old Buckenham Meet on the green near the church. Tetrad recording in TM09. (2)
Sat May 10	TF 712 046 Barton Bendish Meet on the track which leads off the right-angled bend in Boughton Long Road. To survey The Channels (poplar plantation put on Barton Fen where <i>Aquilegia vulgaris</i> was found for the Flora) and Kipper's Wood (ancient woodland). (3)
Thur May 15	TG 171 003 Hethel Meet at the church. Various sites in the area. (4)
Tue May 20	TL 820 880 Santon Street Park north of the railway in the unofficial parking area. To survey in the Brandon valley. (5)
Sat May 31	TG 080 294 Thurning Meet at the church. A number of sites in the area. (6)
Fri June 6	TF 854 273 Helhoughton Common Park on the broad headland to the west of the woodland; also water meadows. (7)
Wed June 11	TG 048 228 Foxley Wood Meet at the northernmost bay of the NWT car park. An informal Carex workshop , as well as general recording - we haven't recorded the site since before 1999. (8)
Thur June 19	TM 053 801 South Lopham Fen Meet at the visitor's centre. (9)

Mon June 23	TF 659 286 Dersingham Bog Meet outside the Natural England office. Pass the (disused) Wolferton railway station and bear right at a grassy triangle. We shall split up and move on to record different parts of the Bog, which will include heathland, mire etc. (10)
Thu June 26	TG 220 364 Roughton Meet at the church. A number of sites in the area and tetrad recording in TG23. (11)
Sun Jun 29	TG 427 054 Wickhampton marshes NNNS 'Wild Flowers Revealed' meeting. Meet at the church. (12)
Tue July 1	TG 265 262 Swanton Abbott Meet at the church car park. Various sites in the area. (13)
Sat July 5	TG 247 103 Mousehold Heath Meet at the north car park off Gurney Road. Rubus workshop with Alec Bull. (14)
Thur July 10	TF 697 228 Grimston Warren Meet promptly at the NWT car park at the Pott Row end as we shall be bunching up into as few cars as possible and going on to the Warren. Grimston Warren adjoins Roydon Common and is part of a restoration project. (15)
Thur July 17	TG 271 197 Coltishall Meet at the church. Various sites in the area and tetrad recording in TG21. (16)
Sun July 20	TF 965 439 Stiffkey marshes and Cockthorpe Common NNNS 'Wildflowers Revealed' meeting. Meet at the NT pay-and-display car park. (17)

Tue July 22	TG 073 179 Lyng Meet at Sparham Pools NWT car park. Various sites in the area. (18)
Tue July 29	TL 937 919 Hockham Woods and Cranberry Rough Meet at the F.C. Picnic Site off the A1075. We shall proceed from there to survey woodland areas with pingos and the recently cleared Cranberry Rough. Wellingtons and midge cream required for the latter (19)
Sat Aug 2	TM 310 998 Berghapton Meet at the church. Various sites in the area. (20)
Thur Aug 14	TF 885 429 Holkham Park Park to the north of the Hall in the general car park. We shall survey areas around the lake, the obelisk and Old Common Plantation. (21)
Tue Aug 19	TG 430 105 Stokesby NB 9.00 am start Meet at the riverside parking area in Stokesby. We will leave some cars here, move on to Yarmouth and walk back (c.11km). As planned in 2007, but changed because of flood works. (22)
Thur Aug 28	am TL 775 954 Cranwich Watermill Broads accessed from a gated private track at TL 773 952 on the A134. pm TF 722 014 Oxborough Oxborough Lakes/Fen accessed via a private track from TF 721 011. Both interesting areas ecologically which have had peat and sand stripped from arable land leaving, variously, exposed chalk and woodland and fenny habitats. Also pm Boughton Fen . (23)
Tue Sep 2	TG 521 137 Caister to Hemsby Meet at the car park. To walk the coast from Caister to Hemsby(c. 5km) (24)
Sat Sep 13	TF 582 247 Wash banks and marshes from Peter Scott Walk Between Clenchwarton and Terrington on the <u>old</u> A17 take the signed Marsh Road, then Rhoon Road and turn right at the sign to Ongar Hill. <i>Hordeum marinum</i> recorded for the Flora. (25)
Sat Sep 20	TM 218 925 Morningthorpe Meet at the church. Tetrad recording in TM29 (26)
Tue Sep 23	TL 615 982 Hilgay and Southery Tetrad recording including Hilgay Poor's Fen. Meet at Dent's Farm Shop and Garden Centre on the west side of the A10. We shall be splitting up and moving on from there. (27)
Tue Sep 30	TM 167 824 Dickleburgh Meets at the church. Late season tetrad recording in TM18. (28)
