


Norfolk Flora Group

Programme of Field Meetings 2010



All meetings start at 10.30 am

Sat Apr 24	TG250 286 Meet at the Weaver's Way car park. Early season tetrad recording. (1)	Felmingham
Thur May 6	TM125 927 Meet at Bunwell church. Early season tetrad recording. (2)	Bunwell
Tue May 11	TG009 302 Meet at the raptor watchpoint on the Fulmodeston to Hindolveston road and then we'll get into as few cars as possible and drive up a track to Warden's caravan at TG010 316. (3)	Swanton Great Wood
Thu May 20	TG181 137 Park in the village and meet opposite the Bob Carter centre. Various sites in the area. (4)	Drayton
Thur May 27	TF975 170 Meet at Gressenhall Museum and park on the lawn on l.h.side as you drive in. We shall be splitting up and going to various CWS's in the Beetley area including unimproved grassland near Old Hall. (5)	Beetley
Tue June 8	TL776 985 am Horrex Farm Turn into the lane Beckett End and park on wide verge on the north side near entrance gate to field. A mixture of habitats including natural chalk springs, ponds, streams, alder carr, fen, marshy grassland, mesotrophic grassland. pm Other sites in the Foulenden area including Coldharbour and Four Score Woods. (6)	Foulenden

Thur June 17	TG329 099 Heading east on the A47, take the first slip road after the Brundall roundabout. Turn left into Shack Lane and park on the side of the road before it narrows. To survey Howes Meadow and Walsham Fen, two sites managed by the Blofield and District Conservation Group. (7)	Blofield
Fri June 25	TF706 209 Meet at the end of Fen Lane, Pott Row, just where it turns sharply left into Watery Lane. Park on verges in Watery Lane. (8)	Hudson and Leziate Fens
Thur July 1	TG359 329 Meet at Walcott Gap. (9)	Walcott
Tue July 6	TF947 291 Turn off the A1067 Fakenham to Norwich Road and follow signs to car park. A mixture of habitats including wet meadows, gardens and arable. (10)	Pensthorpe Nature Reserve
Sat July 10	TG184 175 Meet at the carpark off the east side of Holt Road. Rubus workshop with Alec Bull. (11)	Horsford Woods
Sun July 11	TG088 381 Meet at the Hempstead Road car park north of the Country Park. NNNS 'Wild Flowers Revealed' meeting with Bob Leaney. (12)	Holt Lowes

Thur July 15	TF732 168 Lamb's Common and the Narboroughs Difficult parking along road verges west of meeting point. Pingos, chalk ridges, dykes and fens: some areas very wet. (13)
Wed July 21	TG128 368 Baconsthorpe Old Rectory Hieracium Workshop (and other yellow composites) with David McCosh. Numbers limited, please contact Bob Ellis if you wish to attend. Specimens welcome. (14)
Sat July 24	TG273 388 Trimingham Meet at the long lay-by on the N. side of the coast road. (15)
Thur Aug 5	TG355 166 Horning Meet at Horning church car park. (16)
Thur Aug 12	TL963 852 Bridgham At the west end of Bridgham turn south into an unnamed lane at TL 954 855 and continue to GR. To survey land belonging to Mr Richard Evans at Stonehouse Farm. <i>Sium latifolium</i> found there a few years ago. (17)
Sat Aug 21	TM452 989 Thorpe Marshes Meet at the edge of the slip road off the A143 leading to Haddiscoe station, just to the west of the Haddiscoe Cut bridge. (18)
Tue Aug 24	TF856 041 South Pickenham Park on wide verge outside the church. To survey tetrads in hectad TF80. (19)
Sat Sep 4	TM136 831 Burston Meet at Burston Strike School. Tetrad recording in the Burston and Gissing area. (20)
Tue Sep 7	TL753 889 Hockwold Forest Turn off the Hockwold to Weeting road just west of Weeting NNR into Fire Route 49. There is a small sand pit/quarry with good plant interest, the heathland re-creation site, some recent felling in the area - and some arable margins. (21)
Thur Sep 9	TG170 214 Buxton Heath Hieracium Workshop (and other yellow composites) with David McCosh. Meet at the small car park. A follow-up to the earlier workshop to look for later- flowering hawkweeds. (22)
Thur Sep 23	TF933 429 Wells Park on the broad verge at the entrance to the bridleway off the south side of the A149, east of Wells. We'll walk towards the coast to survey the marshes etc at the east end of Wells and eastwards towards Stiffkey. (23)
Thur Sep 30	TG277 036 Framingham Pigot Meet at the church car park. Tetrad recording in the Framingham area. (24)


