26th To survey FC land at Gravelpit Wood. Meet at the southern end of Fire Road 49, TL75258809 (not far from the Weeting Visitor Centre). (2)

Sat Warren Wood. TL832852.

 5th To survey forestry - meet at Fire Road 16 (TL83288526) on the B1107 from Thetford to Brandon. (3)

Thu Hindolveston Wood. TG039285.

 10th By kind permission. Turn east off the Hindolveston/Foulsham road at TG037285 and follow a track for about 200m to a gateway in the corner of the wood and park just inside. (4)

Thu Knettishall Heath. TL956807.

By request of Suffolk Wildlife Trust we plan to stray across the county boundary (though only by a matter of a few yards) to survey the newly acquired reserve at Knettishall Heath. Park in the public car-park near the cross-roads at TL957807. (5)

Thu Cawston Heath. TG166235.

24th To survey the heath and the restoration area, in particular for *Genista anglica*. Turn north off the Cawston/Marsham road at TG16672316, immediately east of the house, follow the track for 400m and meet at the small car park to the west. (6)

29th Meet at the Buxton Heath car park. Turn east off the Holt road at TG169212 and the track to the car park is to the north of the minor road after c.150m. (7)

31st Two under-recorded tetrads with plenty of lanes and footpaths (some bordering but outside Holkham Park) - park on the road near the village hall (not the main road). (8)

Park at the Stow Bedon car park to the east the A1075 - if approaching from the north take care turning right across the road on the blind bend - or drive further on, turn round, and come back ... Sat North Runcton. TF641155.

16th Under-recorded tetrads east of Setchey including access land at Setchey and North Runcton Commons. Meet south of the pond in North Runcton village (11)

Sun Stody Estate. TG072337.

24th Wild Flowers revealed with Bob Leaney and NNNS. Meet at the Stody Estate Office, Breck Farm, turn off minor road from Briston to Edgefield at TG073334 (12)

Fri Calthorpe Broad. TG409233.

29th Our visit depends on the state of the water levels. Please ring Alex Prendergast on 07707 355504 a few days beforehand to check. Meet at the car park by the pond in Hickling Green. We'll move on sharing cars, so please be prompt. (13)

Sat Bramble Workshop. TF697228.

30th With Alec Bull. Roydon Common and other sites in the area. Meet at the NWT car park at the eastern end of Roydon Common. (14)

Thu 5 th	Melton Constable. TG056331. Manor Farm. Various habitats including lots of ponds, arable margins etc. Meet at the farm on the north side of the Fakenham Road, just east of a T junction. (15)
Thu 12 th	West Runton to Cromer. TG184431. Coastal tetrad recording. Meet at the West Runton Beach car park. (16)
Sat 14 th	West Winch. TF628156. Tetrad recording east of West Winch including access land at West Winch Common and footpaths along the River Nar. Park verge on the roadside (Hall Lane) in the village near Clarkes Chase Track. (17)

Fri 17 th	Ludham, Horse Fen. TG396177. Meet at the Broads Authority base on Horsefen Road, Ludham. (23)
Th	Kudu, Luunani. (25)
Thu 23 rd	Syderstone Common. TF835314. To check for <i>Genista anglica</i> and record surrounding byways. There is a small reserve car- park on the minor road to Syderstone Village. (24)

Sat Upton. TG402127.

8th Riverbank and marshes. Meet at the Broads Authority car park at the end of Upton Dyke. The area has had a lot of recent 'disturbance' and change – NWT have created a number of new scrapes and slubbed dykes out over the last 2 years; BESL have removed several km of piling and lowered the old bank as well as re-shaping a length upstream of Black Mill and the BA has been depositing dredgings between the old bank and new setback bank. Thu Wiggenhall St Germans. TF593141.

13th Tetrad recording on the many riverside rights-ofway where the Great Ouse and the Middle Level Main Drain meet. Meet at the memorial hall/recreation ground car park off Sluice Road. (27)

Sat Conifer workshop. TG139411.

22nd Sheringham Park. With Mary Ghullam. NT have been kind enough to allow us use of the learning centre. Meet at the centre (the entrance to the NT pay-and-display car park is at TG13924106) (28)
