Field Meetings 2014

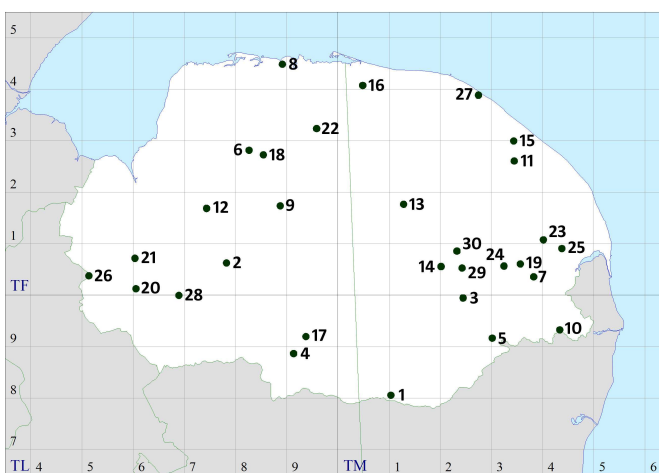
All meetings start at 10.30 am

Tue 15th April	Diss. TM103805. Meet on Brewers Green near the junction between Manor Road and Brewers Green Lane. Mainly to record urban Diss. 1
Sat 3rd May	Cockley Cley Forestry. TF782062. Meet at the public car park near Drymere 2
Sat 10th May	Shotesham. TM256967. Meet (park on the verge) at Lathe Green (junction of Wash Lane/Market Lane, TM25689679) and go on in fewer vehicles. Shotesham Little Wood and other sites. For those so inclined, we will round off the day in the Brooke King's Head 3
Thu 15th May	Croxton or Roudham Forestry. Meet at the car park for Langmere on the A1075 – TL913886 (where we met last year). We will move on to forestry either near Croxton (depending on permissions for access) or near Roudham Heath (depending on A11 roadworks). 4
Thu 22nd May	Sexton Wood. TM301916. Park on hard standing in the wood. Access the wood from Sexton Road at TM30159163 5
Tue 27th May	East and West Rudham. Meet at the village green – about TF826281 (the western end of the triangle may be easiest). Watch out for speed camera vans on the edges of the village, and the fern-like <i>Corydalis cheilanthifolia</i> naturalized on a wall. We should have access to some private land, plus West Rudham Common access land and plenty of paths. 6
Sat 31st May	Cantley Factory. TG382035. Please go to the reception building, which is at TG38230356 to sign in (cross the railway line, and bear left, then it's a single storey building on the left just after the bend). You will then be directed to a parking area, where we will meet up. If you think that you are likely to attend, please ring Jo on 07710 252468 or email jo.parmenter@tlp.uk.com one week before the meeting as approx. numbers have to be supplied to the factory. Please note that their H&S policy requires you to wear a long-sleeved shirt or top, and long trousers, NOT shorts, and sturdy lace-up boots. Note that the site is handily situated for the Reedcutters PH. 7

Thu 5th June	Holkham Meals. TF891448. Though the VCRs often get sent records for this well known site, amazingly NFG have not recorded it systematically for many years. Meet in the expensive car park at Lady Anne's Drive – TF891448 (you may want to share cars). 8
Tue 10th June	Litcham and Honeypot Wood. TF887173. We will record access land and paths around Litcham with an excursion for those interested to Honeypot Wood. Meet at the public car-park on Litcham Common 9
Sat 14th June	Aldeby. TM433932. Meet at Stanley Hills car park TM43329326, off Hollow Way Hill. We will walk into Stanley/Alder Carrs from there and move on to Aldeby Hall in the afternoon, and round off the day at the White Lion at Wheatacre 10
Sat 21st June	Dilham Broad Fen. TG344260. Park just off Oak Road in front of the big modern barn at TG34422608 (please do not block doors/access). We will visit Dilham Broad Fen and South Fen in the morning, and then move on to the woodland at Honing Common in the afternoon. Optional post-meeting visit to Dilham Cross Keys 11
Thu 26th June	Walton Common. Another classic site not recorded by NFG for at least ten years (the moss group may have been there). If all else fails meet in East Walton village TF743168 but parking is difficult (do NOT park on the main road – it is a racetrack) – hopefully we will be able to arrange parking (we will circulate details, but otherwise ring RNC or Bob a few days before). 12
Sun 29th June	Attlebridge, Marriott's Way /Alderford Common. TG128176. Jointly with NNNS. Meet at the Marriott's Way car park. Turn west off Station Road onto the track at TG12931760, just north of where the old level crossing was. 13
Sat 5th July	Crangleford. TG201055. Meet at Oakfield Recreation Ground, TG20110555. One group will go on from there to access sites N of the A11. 14

Sat 12th July	Crostwight Heath. TG343299. <i>Rubus</i> Workshop with Alec Bull. Meet on the north side of Heath Road. 15
Thu 17th July	Bayfield Hall estate. TG048407. Meet at the 'Natural Surroundings' car park. 16
Sat 19th July	Frost's Common and Cranberry Rough. Woodland with pingos and perhaps a stab at the northern side of Cranberry Rough which we did not get to last year. Meet at the large car park on the A1075 - TL937919 (where we met last year). We will go on in a few cars to a small lay-by at Frost's Common. 17
Thu 24th July	Helhoughton. Details to be confirmed. 18
Sat 26th July	Buckenham Carrs. TG356060. Meet at the 'Red Barn' at TG35660601, just off School Road Buckenham. The barn is at the top of the minor road which leads down to St Nicholas's Church. 19
Wed 30th July	Denver. TF605012. A visit to commons south of Denver plus paths in the district. Unless we say otherwise assume we have permission to park at the Windmill tea rooms 20
Sat 2nd August	Stow Bridge. A 'Flora of the Fenland' meeting. Meet at the public car park at TF603071. 21
Fri 8th August	Little Snoring. Details to be confirmed. 22
Sat 16th August	Acle. TG401107. Meet on west side of Acle Recreation/Sports Centre car park at TG40141077. We will split into smaller groups and go on from there. Mainly to survey Constable Doles and Damgate Marshes. 23
Tue 19th August	Surlingham. TG324056. Workshop on <i>Lemna</i> and <i>Callitriche</i> with Tim Pankhurst. Wheatfen Study Centre. Please let Bob know if you are planning to attend. 24
Sat 23rd August	Halvergate Marshes. TG437090. Meet in the restaurant car park just to the west of the Stracey Arms windmill at TG43780903. We will split into 2 or more groups and go on from there in fewer vehicles. Obligatory visit to Embrujo at 5pm for a cerveza afterwards to say thank you for the use of their car park 25
Sat 30th August	Outwell. A 'Flora of the Fenland' meeting. Meet at the church in the large village of Outwell TF513037 (avoid driving into the river beside the bendy main road to Outwell). 26
Thu 4th Sept	Trimingham. TG274388. Meet in the long lay-by on the coast road at the western edge of the village. Tetrad bashing and a look at the foot of the cliffs and strandline. 27
Tue 9th Sept	Wretton. A 'Flora of the Fenland' meeting. Meet near the church in the village of Wretton TL689999 (street parking) – if we can arrange parking we will circulate details. 28

Sun 14th Sept	Norwich. TG242082. Meet at Jonathan Scott Hall TG24260825 (converted chapel). Parking is round to the left of the building. Come round to the front of the building (right hand door) and press the buzzer for The Landscape Partnership. Jo has promised tea, coffee and cake on your arrival. We will split into smaller groups and go on from here. Various sites in the eastern part of the city. Optional end to the day in the Coach and Horses. 29
Thu 9th Oct	Norwich, Shirehall. TG232085. Workshops on use of the herbarium and on alien grasses with Tony Irwin & Bob Leaney. The entrance to the Shirehall is on Market Avenue. Please bring any specimens of alien grasses you collect during the year. Please let Bob Ellis know if you are planning to attend. 30
